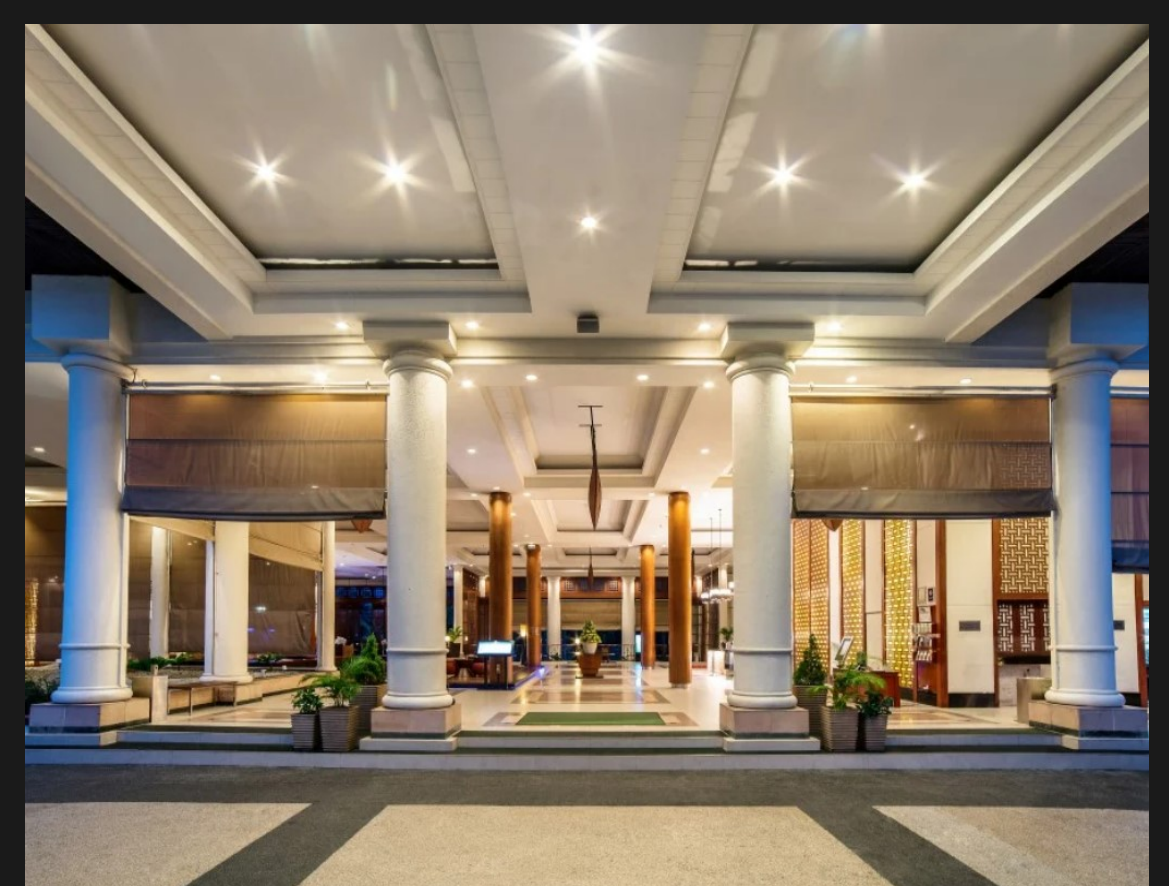


Tradewinds launches Glenmarie Hotel & Golf Resort

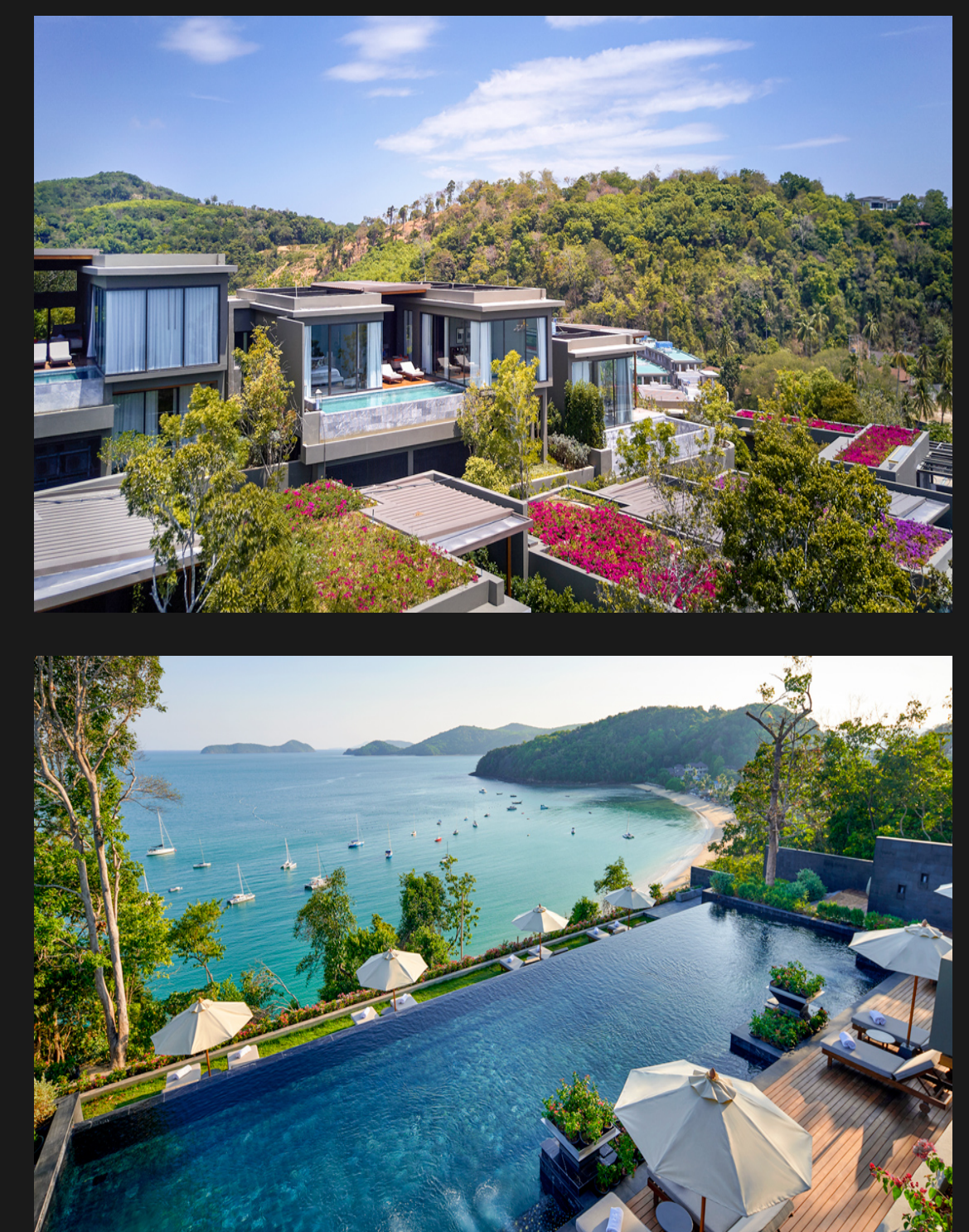
MGallery's New All Villa Resort Debuts In Thailand

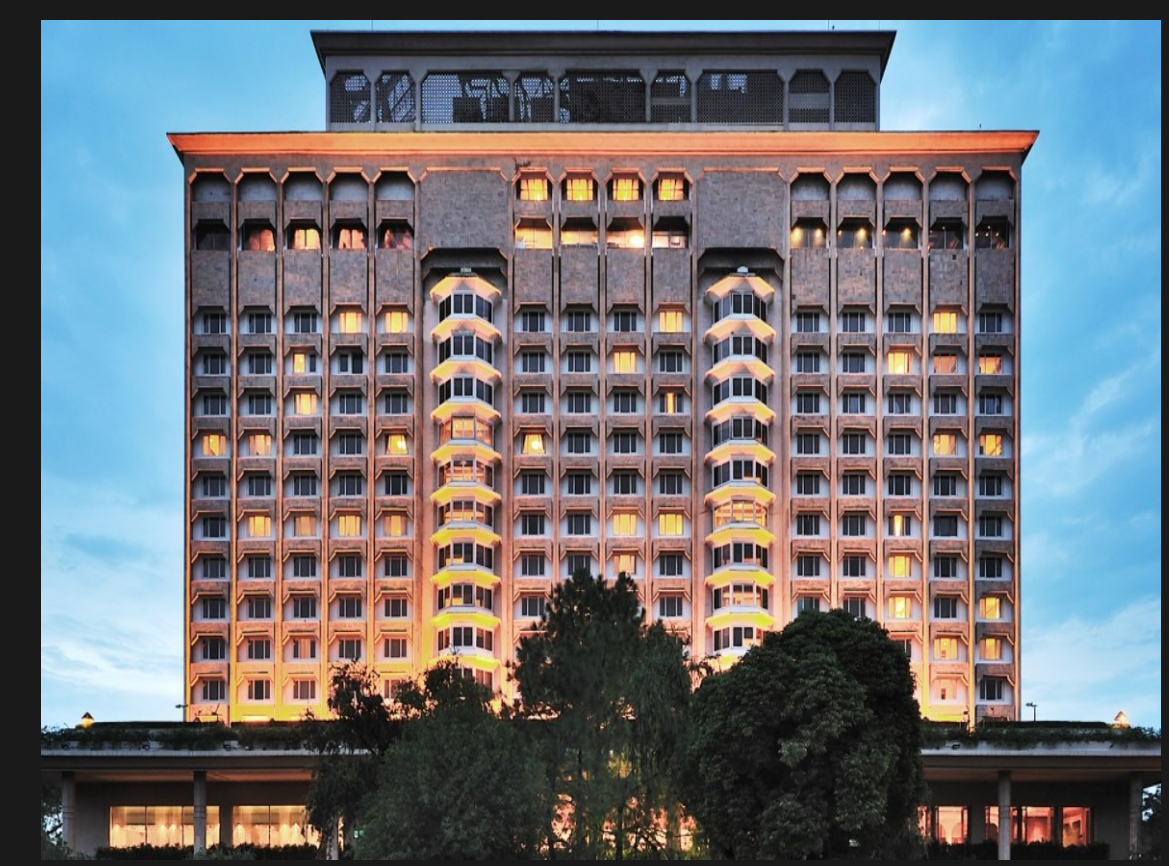
