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Berjaya Group set to open more hotels in Iceland, including a Four Seasons brand

Berjaya Land Bhd (BLand) intends to acquire and operate more hotels in Iceland.

BLand will open Iceland Parliament Hotel, its 15th hotel in Iceland, in the first half of next year to meet rising demand.

The hotel, which has 163 Scandinavian-style rooms, is a 50:50 collaboration between Dalsnes and Icelandair Group and is located next to the Icelandic Parliament.

By the middle of next year BLand will operate a total of 1634 rooms in Iceland and the numbers will expand. [READ MORE](#)



Plenitude sees upward trend for hospitality, property divisions

Plenitude's hospitality assets are Novotel Kuala Lumpur City Centre, Oakwood Hotel & Residence in Kuala Lumpur, Mercure Penang Beach, Travelodge Georgetown, and Ascott Gurney Penang Travelodge Ipoh and Travelodge Myeongdong Euljiro, Seoul, South Korea.

The company will be launching Ascott Gurney Penang in the first quarter of 2022, after a complete refurbishment, with 271 keys and a ballroom capacity of 550 covers.

The capital expenditure for the Ascott Gurney Penang upgrading works is budgeted at RM120 million.

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Pan Pacific Signs Two Properties in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

Pan Pacific will first expand the Parkroyal Collection beyond the shores of Singapore with the launch of Parkroyal Collection Kuala Lumpur in June 2022.

That property will be followed by the opening of the 210-key Pan Pacific Serviced Suites Kuala Lumpur in October 2022, yet another first with the group's signature Pan Pacific flag in Malaysia.
